*For the first eight months a refugee is in the United States*

### Primary Care Network (PCN)

*For adults who do not qualify for Medicaid; call for enrollment information*

### Transportation

*If you do not have your own transportation to and from your medical appointments, you can ask for a Utah Transit Authority (UtahA) bus pass by calling your Medicaid Eligibility Worker. If there is a medical reason you can't use the bus, you may qualify for services through UTA FlexTrans. To apply for this service, call the Medicaid Information Line at 1-801-538-6155 or toll free at 1-800-662-9651 and ask for the Transportation Unit. Non-emergency transportation is covered by Medicaid. Call PickMeUp Medical Transport at (toll free) 1-888-822-1048. Salt Lake County Aging Services provides transportation for life-sustaining medical appointments. You must be at least 60 years old and lack other transportation options.*
